YWCA of Contra Costa/Sacramento Housing Program

Information

The YWCA of Contra Costa/Sacramento is a single-room occupancy facility that accommodates low-income single women only. No children, pets or overnight guests are allowed. To be considered for residency at the YWCA, your annual total income must meet low-income guidelines.

Amenities: Each room is furnished with a twin bed, dresser, sink, light, closet, ceiling fan, and window. There are shared communal bathrooms on each floor and one private bathroom. There is a shared kitchen with shared refrigerators, a stove, table and chairs, and individual food storage lockers on the 2nd floor. The shared living room with a TV, VCR, sofas, ironing board and iron is on the 3rd floor and another area for rest and relaxation is located on the 2nd floor. A coin-operated washer and dryer are located on the 3rd floor and a pay phone is available on the 2nd floor. There is an enclosed courtyard with a garden for relaxation and a smoking area for smokers.

Utilities: Water, garbage, gas and electricity are included in your rent. You may have a phone in your room, but you must contact AT & T to arrange and pay for it yourself.

How to Apply?

Step 1: Fill out the Occupancy Application. Upon completion of your application, your name will be placed on the waiting list. Since this is a long-term transitional living facility, it is impossible for us to know how long it will be before your name comes to the top of the list. Periodically, you will be called or sent a notice to see if you are still interested in remaining on the list. If we don't hear from you after contacting you, we will assume you are no longer interested in remaining on the list and your name will be removed.

Step 2: When your name comes up, we will contact you and have you **pay the \$15.00 credit check fee.** We are looking for evictions, not your credit rating. You will also be required to sign a Release of Information for income verification. You will be required to show proof of income so keep your pay stubs or your receipts from disability.

Step 3: Once your application is approved, you will **return with the total deposit and prorated rent (as figured by the Residential Property Manager) and receive your keys.**
